"AFRICAN SKY", 00384 in the RB
This ship is at present in dry dock at Flushing
for condition and damage repairs.

The Master has been informed that the boiler survey
was overdue from the end of December 1957, but in reply he
stated that the boilers had been surveyed in Italy in March, 1958
by the ABS Surveyors.

The ABS Surveyor was also present in dry dock at
Flushing.

Mr. Auer, the Principal Surveyor at Rotterdam for
ABS stated, when approached, that it is the Owners' intention
to have the ship classed by ABS, but at present he has no
information whether the class has been accepted by their
Head Office at New York.

Meantime the following recommendations have been
made to the Master:

Rudder to be unshipped and placed in order
(Badly worn bushing)
Screwshaft to be drawn and sternbush to renew.
Boilers to be prepared for survey.

We shall be pleased to learn at your earliest
convenience whether any information has reached your office
that the Owners desire the Society's class to be withdrawn.
