*Surveyed the m.v. "TRITONICA", 12863 tons gross of London, on the 10th October, 1957, and subsequently, as she lay afloat and in dry dock at Sunderland, on account of Damage, Alterations and drydocking and that I will transmit to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a Report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I will Recommend that she be continued as classed in the Register Book, with fresh record of D.S. 11,57, subject to set in shell plates G.12 and 13, H.11 and 14 (S.S. from forward) and set up shell plates Keel 2, A.2(ps), A.3 (ss) from forward being examined at the next dry docking and dealt with as necessary by next Special Survey; also to distorted hatch coaming plating and deck angles, p.s. No. 2 Hatch and s.s.No. 5 Hatch, and indented side ballast tank bulkhead plating, p.s. of Nos. 2 and 4 Hatches, being repaired at next Special Survey being fit to carry dry and perishable cargoes.*
