With reference to the Owners' letter of the 7th ultimo, a carbon copy of which, it is understood, is in your possession, respecting the Motorship "HERBRAND", I have to acquaint you that their proposal to extend the period for the further examination of the remaining original pistons until the end of June next was duly approved and the Society's Surveyor at Wellington was informed accordingly.

In consequence of reports received from Bremen, Lloyd's Agents at Busreh, and Wellington, the following survey notations have recently been assigned:-

A fresh docking date 8,50 Bhn.,  
S.S.Bmn.- 8,50, @ L.M.C.8,50,  
@ N.E.8,50, @ N.D.B.(2) 8,50,  
and record of new screwshafts 8,50.

The class is subject to 30 fathoms of chain cable being supplied at the earliest opportunity and to Port Nos.1,2 & 3 and Starboard No.1 pistons being further examined by the end of June next.

Certificates to this effect are enclosed for transmission to the Owners together with an account in respect of the fees relating to the survey carried out by the Bremen Surveyor. The enclosed copies of interim certificates relating to the Bremen survey should also be sent to the Owners.

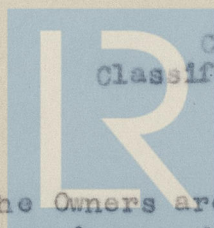
