and that I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am recommending that she ~~be~~ retained as classed without fresh record of dry docking and to shell plating in strake 3rd below sheer and between frame Nos. 5 & 9 from fore'd bulkhead in Hold No. 3 port side being faired and to the two damaged propeller blades and rudder being specially examined and dealt with as found necessary at the time of the next dry docking and to all other conditions of class being dealt with as previously recommended.
