IT IS SUBMITTED the Piraeus Surveyors be informed, in reply to their letter of the 20th November, that it is customary to base the fees for the first classification of an existing ship on twice the periodical special survey fees, compatible with the ship's age and type. Based on this and the information available, it is estimated that for classification, i.e. special surveys of the hull, machinery, boilers, screwshaft and electrical equipment, a fee in Greece of £1,160 would be chargeable.

No account has been taken of the alterations, wear and tear repairs or damage, and it is felt that the Piraeus Surveyors may wish to enhance the fees in view of these items.
