Electrical Installation.

Further to previous correspondence in connection with the proposed classification of the above vessel, we would now advise you that the electrical plans forwarded by the Builders have now been examined.

In order that full consideration may be given to the arrangements we shall be glad if you will kindly ascertain and let us know the following information:

- (1) The type of cables used throughout the installation.
- (2) The make and type of fuses used.

Further, it appears that electrical equipment other than flameproof lighting fittings is installed in the pumproom and further details of this equipment should be forwarded for consideration.

Plans showing the lighting arrangements on the main deck, in the midships 'tween-deck space and the pumproom, and indicating the type of fittings used, should also be forwarded. With regard to the pumproom lighting it should be noted that the arrangements are to comply with M.1533 or M.1534 (previously M.1535 and M.1536).
