Motorship "HIGHLAND MONARCH"

The report of the General Examination held while this ship was in drydock in London last January has now received the consideration of the Committee.

In view of the satisfactory nature of this report, postponement of the Special Survey until April, 1961, has now been approved.

As a result of this survey the Committee have continued the class subject to pitted shell plates Nos. 2 and 3 in 5th strake below sheer (port and starboard aft) being specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the next drydocking, and to all main engine connecting rods being examined on the ship's return to the United Kingdom.

A record of Drydocking 1,60 has now been assigned.
