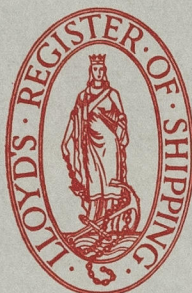

**This is to Certify** *that I have surveyed part of the machinery of the m.s. "STIRLINGSHIRE" 6987 gross tons of Glasgow, for damage to the starboard side main standby S.W. circulating pump engine, as the pump shaft lay at workshops in Mombasa on 23rd June, 1966 & subsequently on the vessel at Mombasa, and that all my recommendations have been carried out to my satisfaction. I am reporting accordingly and recommending to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping that the machinery classification should be retained and the following ~~survey records assigned~~ without fresh record of survey and without condition regarding main standby S.W. pump engine crankshaft but subject to any conditions of class remaining as previously recommended.*

Parts now examined:—

Damaged standby S.W. pump engine crankshaft.  
Replacement shaft and pump under working conditions.
