
S.R.L. No.235:

Owners state that the drydock at Karachi will not be available before August, 1965.

The general service pump sea suction valve chest which became due for renewal in 3/65 externally examined this time and found to continue efficient.

It is submitted that postponement of renewal of this valve until August, 1965 merits the favourable consideration of the Committee.

The reason for repairs must be stated and those on account of damage, the alleged cause of which must be given, should be detailed separately from wear and tear repairs. State what action has been taken regarding items which are subjects of class. State also where appropriate, for the information of the Technical Records Dept., the material of the defective item and whether it is a forging, casting or welded fabrication. Any alterations in existing particulars in the Register Book should be reported above.
