Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in

Strong steel companionway adequately supported now fitted on port side of tonnage hatch (permanently closed) giving access to the additional accommodation space for gunners in after shelter tween deck fitted at Cardiff.

Companionway fitted with strong hinged ^{WOOD} ~~steel~~ door operated both sides and with 24" coaming above deck.

W.C.'s. arranged port side of tween deck with 4" dia. overside discharge led through ship's side above upper deck level & fitted with screw down, automatic non return valves operated from shelter deck.

On starboard side washbasins arranged with 2" dia. discharge also led overboard above upper deck level and with screw down automatic non return valves operated from shelter deck.

Additional portlights fitted port & starboard to this accommodation and complete with efficient hinged deadlight.
