Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines in

ADDITIONAL ACCOMMODATION FITTED IN NOS. TWEEN DECKS, PORT SIDE.

Hinged W.T. door fitted on W.T. bulkhead, frame 29, port side.

1. Ventilator 14" dia, cranking 30" x 36

2 " 9" dia " 30" x 32.

1 " 6" dia " 30" x 32.

fitted with wood plugs & canvas covers.

3. additional side scuttles fitted, 10" dia, with hinged steel deadlights.

One escape hatch, 24" dia, 6" cranking, Admiralty type with hinged W.T. cover.

One W.C. discharge with double automatic valves and storm valve on ship's side.

Wash basin & sink discharge with double automatic self closing valves.

Surge pump from wash place led to funnel well with weighted cork under funnel flt.
