Mizzenstay in good order, screw to overhaul.
Shrouds in good order, screws to clean down and wrap.
Preventer stays, with screws, shackles and eyeplates, in good order.
Topmast backstays, with screws, shackles and eyeplates, in good order.
Preventer stays and backstays to set up.

Funnel Stays with lanyards and ringplates, to set up.
