I have to acquaint you that your Reports of Survey, numbered below, have been submitted to the Committee, and your recommendations confirmed except as stated:

6903, 09. As recommended.

— 6898 "WYCHWOOD". As recommended. I have to point out that in February last the Liverpool Surveyors recommended that the stem and stem plating etc. should be examined and dealt with as necessary at the next drydocking. It is concluded that this item was examined at this time and found to continue efficient and that no alterations are required in the Special Reasons List, but I shall be glad to receive your confirmation.

6904 "TERRA NOVA". As recommended, except that the class has been made subject to the screwshaft being re-examined by April, 1956, (metal sprayed) and the record of survey in this respect withheld.
