The ship has notation of 'SS(M) 3,59(12 mos)'

Due to extensive anticipated wear and tear repairs the Owners proposal to carry out a Modified S.S. (12 mos) was approved - refer letter dated 21.3.60 provided the ship is fully opened up as for a Special Survey and all necessary repairs effected for a 12month period.

The HULL Surveyors report ship examined afloat and in dry dock and the requirements of a Modified S.S.(C) complied with.

Wear and tear repairs effected.

In view of the above IT IS SUBMITTED the ship is eligible to remain as now classed and to have record of 'DS 4,60' and Notation 'SS (M) 4,60 (12 mos)' assigned.
