LIZZONIA.—Niton Radio, Mar. 16.—
 Following received from motor vessel
 ARCTIC OCEAN, SEYT, (Buenos Aires
 for Stockholm) at 8 45 a.m., G.M.T.:
 Been in collision with motor vessel
 Lizzonia, have all crew safe on board
 here. Position of Lizzonia three miles
 WNW. of Varne Light-vessel, last seen
 afloat but lost sight of in dense fog. No
 damage to our vessel.
 London, Mar. 16. —
 Messages reaching Dungeness said that
 motor vessel Lizzonia sank almost
 immediately after collision. It was
 reported that motor vessel, ARCTIC
 OCEAN had decided to land the crew
 of the Lizzonia at Malmö, her next port
 of call.
