that I have Recommended that she be continued as classed without fresh record of survey, notation of SS. (with date) when the survey has been completed and subject to wasted plating and structure of chainlocker, former spare bunkers, of DB. tanks Nos. 3-4-and 5, of space around rudder trunk, wasted forward and aft deckplating etc. being dealt with on arrival at Djakarta before the end of April 1953

being fit to carry dry and perishable cargo.
