Sir

With reference to your letter of Dec. 1st 1902 regarding the insulation of the electric light cables of S.S. "Hektor" Messrs R. Craggs & Sons No 180.

I communicated the contents of that letter to the electrical engineers representative here. After taking a day to consider it, he stated that his firm would guarantee that the resistance of insulation was up to that required by Par. 4 of the rules.

On the work on this ship being completed, I gave him the report for him to obtain the signature of his firm to the guarantee.

He returned to Helsingfors. After a long delay, and my having to write to Helsingfors asking for its return, it was sent back with the insulation resistance guarantee for 300 megohms only.

On my writing, pointing out the discrepancy the enclosed reply has been

received after another month's delay.

In consequence of the long delays two other vessels, the S.S. "Leo" and S.S. "Hesperus". Messrs R Craggs & Sons 18/11/82 have been completed with similar insulation of electric light cables

This letter, now referring to three ships, I submit with the report for the consideration of the Committee.
