The case of the above named ship has been reconsidered by the Committee today in the light of your cablegram of the 28th April, for which I am obliged.

In reply, I have been authorised to say that the Committee will not object to a further deferment of the overdue Special Survey for three months, provided the ship is completely opened up and examined afloat as for Special Survey with repairs limited to the period contemplated. Dry-docking of the ship may be deferred provided you concur bearing in mind your last inspection in January, 1964.

So far as the machinery is concerned, at least 50% of the crankshaft, journals and bearings should be opened up before the end of the present month.

I have cabled this decision to you today and shall be glad to learn whether the Owner proposes to take advantage of this concession.
