I have to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 4th instant enclosing your report of part General Examination carried out on the hull of this ship.

I would point out that the full list of items remaining to complete this inspection is as follows:-

Internal examination of the forepeak tank, afterpeak and a few frame spaces of water ballast double bottom tanks immediately forward and abaft of machinery space.

Examination of the auxiliary steering gear.

In addition no report has been received from you on the General Examination of the machinery, or the advancement of the Engine Survey as instructed in my letter of the 10th April last.


