recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, and
that I have Recommended that she be continued as now classed
(viz. #100A1) with fresh Docking Date 11,52, and the notation of
"Fitted for Oil Fuel 11,52 P.P. above 150°F" when the installation
has been tested under working conditions, she
being fit to carry dry and perishable cargoes.
