Regarding your letter of 24th ult.,
& the 4th inst., relating to the verification of
freeboard for the s/s "Helle" in "Marguerite", I have
to state that the vessel was visited once in Tyne
Dock, & twice whilst lying in Plym., but owing
to the position of the vessel it has been impossible to
check or have amended the markings on the
ship's side.

The chief officer, however, stated that the vessel was
sailing for Malmo where she would be dry docked, &
have the freeboard attended to there.
