Dear Sir,

M. I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 8th instant respecting the case of the Steamer "MARGUERITE", and to acquaint you that the contents have been noted.

I have to inform you, however, that to entitle this vessel to the freeboards assigned, the portable plate on the starboard side of the bridge front bulkhead will require to be secured by nut and screw bolts passing through the bulkhead plating and spaced not more than 6 inches apart, or the plate be attached to the bulkhead by riveted hinges and clips.

I shall be glad if you will give particulars of the method of securing the portable plate when forwarding your verification of marking form.
