Dear Sir,

I enclose a copy of a letter dated 13th instant received from Messrs. Petrie & Berggren, of your port, desiring to be furnished with copies of the Anchor and Chain Cable Test Certificates and also of the freeboard certificates for the S.S. "MARGUERITE" ex "ADRANA", which is under your survey with a view to reclassification.

The First Entry Report on this vessel is in your possession, and I shall be glad if you will state whether the anchors and chains now on board correspond to those originally supplied, and if not forward particulars of the markings and test numbers of those which are actually on board the ship, in order that it may be decided whether the request of the Owners can be complied with.

With regard to the request for copies of the freeboard certificates, I may say that freeboard certificates were issued by the Danish Government through this Society in 1910, but are no longer valid. I shall therefore be glad if you will interview the Owners regarding the matter, and ascertain whether freeboard assignment is now desired.
