Dear Sirs,

I refer to the drilling rig "TRITON" which was built under the supervision of the Society's Surveyors at Wallsend between April, 1959 and January, 1960.

This rig will be entitled to the class #A1 "Lake Maracaibo Service" when a report has been received on its satisfactory condition on arrival with in the service area. With a view to the necessary inspection being carried out, I wrote to the Society's Surveyor at Caracas with the request that arrangements should be made for survey, and in reply he stated that according to Messrs. Compania Shell de Venezuela Ltd. at Maracaibo, the rig has not arrived in Venezuela and apparently is not destined for service there.

I shall be glad if you can furnish me with particulars of the service on which the drilling rig will be engaged, so that arrangements can be made for an examination to be carried out by one of the Society's Surveyors, the class assigned and the Classification Certificates issued.
