the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of the Owners attend on board the Drilling Rig "Triton" (Messrs. Clelands (Successors) Limited, Yard No. 243) on the 29th September, 1959 and subsequently for the purpose of inspecting the electrical equipment, during installation and testing.

The power units consist of the following:-

1 - 45 K.W. diesel driven Alternator Set, 440 Volts - 3 phase 60 cycles for lighting and small power.

4 - 136 K.W. diesel driven Alternator Sets, 440 Volts - 3 phase 60 cycles for operation of winches, and other deck machinery.

The equipment was installed in accordance with approved plans, and on completion of erection the following tests were carried out satisfactorily:-

45 K.W. Alternator set tested at full load for governing, voltage control, and insulation resistance.

4 - 136 K.W. Alternator sets tested at full load for governing, voltage control, parallel operation and insulation resistance.

All auxiliary motors seen under working conditions and found to be in order. Insulation resistance test taken.

As far as now seen the equipment was found to be sound and efficiently installed, and considered suitable for a vessel classed with this Society.
