Memorandum of alterations reported since ship was surveyed for assignment of Load Lines
in 1932.

Additional accommodation for 10 gunners fitted at after-end of
Bridge tween deck on port side.

Steel companion with 21" sill, wood hinged door operated both
sides fitted on bridge deck.

As an emergency exit a W.T. door has been fitted in bolted plate
on port side of aft bridge bulkhead and bolted plate packed.

2-10" sidelights in accommodation and 1-10" in W.C. all with
hinged deadlights.

W.C. and washbasins fitted with stormvalves above freeboard deck.
