I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 20th ultimo, relative to the steamer "MARIA CRISTINA PRIMEIRO", and to acquaint you that the Committee have had this case under consideration, and that the Owners' remarks relative to Insurance Premiums have been noted by them with much interest.

In all the circumstances the Committee have given instructions for the vessel's class to be withdrawn and three dots inserted in lieu thereof, and I enclose a letter addressed to the new Owners, which I shall be glad if you will kindly have passed on to them. As all Portuguese Shippers I am, Dear Sir, compelled to have their vessels periodically examined by

Surveyors and pay the survey fees, by withdrawing the vessels from class, the apparently unnecessary expense of paying classification fees is saved.
