I have met the Manager of the Company who stated that were any benefit in insurance premiums to be obtained the vessel would be continued in Class, but it is found that whether vessels are Classed or not the premiums are the same.

As all Portuguese Shipping Companies are compelled to have their vessels periodically examined by the Port Surveyors, and have to pay the survey fees, by unclassing the vessel the class fees would be saved as no benefit is to be had in making this expense.

It is to be regretted that some action is not taken by Underwriters in these cases as this feeling is slowly but surely gaining ground here, and I often hear it discussed.
