I have your letter of the 18th November, the contents of which have been noted, and would inform you that the Committee have previously approved to the Special Survey due so long ago as August 1959, being postponed until the end of February when the vessel was due at Hong Kong for breaking up.

It is concluded the new Owners intend to employ the vessel and maintain classification with this Society and that the Special Survey will be carried out on arrival in your district which, it is concluded, will be before the end of February.

I shall be glad if you will inform the new Owners accordingly and furnish me with their comments in due course.

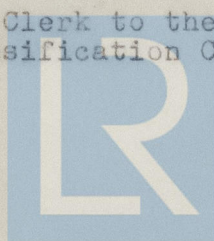
