Information received from our Leith Surveyor confirm that the s.s. "BOUVET 1" which sank at anchor during severe snow storm at Leith Harbour, South Georgia, in September, has been declared a total loss.

However, the m.s. "SOUTHERN PAUL", m.s. "SOUTHERN PETER" and s.s. "SABRA" together with three other whalers, names at present unknown, are also reported sunk.

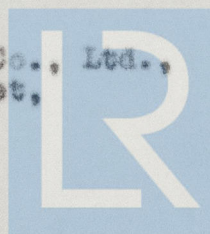
In the circumstances, I shall be glad if you will let me know the exact date the casualties occurred together with the names of the other whalers lost, and at the same time, kindly confirm that they, together with m.s. "SOUTHERN PAUL", m.s. "SOUTHERN PETER" and s.s. "SABRA" have been declared total losses.

The s.s. "SOUTHERN FOSTER" now reported afloat at Leith Harbour, is presumed not to be a total loss, but your confirmation on this point will be appreciated.
