With reference to Freeboard Verification forwarded herewith we have to inform you that the following requirements have been carried out :-

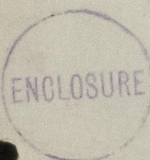
- (1) Canvas covers fitted to all goose neck ventilators and air pipes.
