 CAYMANIA. — Cristobal, Dec. 31. — Steamer Caymania, anchored Colon Bay since August, 1962, finally sank last week at anchorage in approximately 30 ft. of water. (Note—Caymania was towed to Cristobal on Aug. 16, 1962, in leaky condition.)

22/1/64  
 QUIBIAN. — Cristobal, Dec. 31. — Steamer Quibian (ex CAYMANIA), anchored Colon Bay since August, 1962, finally sank last week at anchorage in approximately 30 ft. of water. (Note—CAYMANIA was towed to Cristobal on Aug. 16, 1962, in leaky condition. was sold in 1962 and renamed Quibian. Not as reported in issue of Jan. 2.)

 QUIBIAN.—London, Mar. 2.—In reply to inquiry, Lloyd's Agents at Cristobal write under date of Feb. 25: Messrs. Federico Ford, S.A., state that no attempt has been made so far to raise steamer Quibian, ex CAYMANIA, at present lying sunk in Colon harbour, and it is understood that her owners do not contemplate any such arrangements for the near future.
