The question of fees for Survey during construction and First Entry of class for vessels which were built in enemy/territory, ^{or enemy occupied} "DRUPA", "DON ISIDRO", "ESSO BALBOA" etc., and for which no First Entry Reports were received, was ^{been} specially considered and it was assumed that the fees had been paid by the builders and ^{considered} that no further action was necessary.

In reply to their inquiry, the Surveyors should be informed, it is assumed that the fees for Survey during construction and First Entry of class were duly paid by the builders at Rotterdam and that the fee now to be charged should be assessed to cover the services rendered in respect of the General Examination, alterations etc.
