00485 "EMPIRE SALVAGE" I duly received your letter of the 22nd ultimo and it is assumed as in other cases of a similar nature which have already been dealt with, that the fees for survey during construction and First Entry of Class were duly paid by the builders. It is therefore considered so far as the hull is concerned, that a suitable fee should now be charged to cover the services rendered by you in respect of the General Examination, alterations etc. With regard to the machinery, it is thought a suitable fee will be £20.0.0. for the survey of the engines, £3.0.0. for the Boiler Survey and £4.0.0. for the electrical equipment.
