With reference to your classing letter of 8th instant, we have to state that the midship bulkhead reported was intended to be bulkhead 69.

The thickness of the bottom strake is .38 for the two centre plates and the wing plates are .44.

These thicknesses are as originally fitted in the ship, the builders having noted the thicknesses of the two centre plates on the deep tank plan as .44 in error instead of .38.

A horizontal girder has been fitted.

It is regretted that this was not made clear.
