

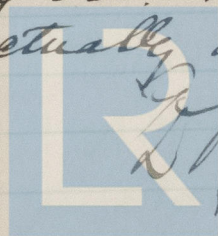

Rule 805-8.

Before this case receives consideration it is submitted the Surveyor be informed that it is not understood why a final temperature of -17°C (1.4°F) is not considered low enough for frozen cargo in view of the fact that the Rules require a temperature of about 10°F at a cooling test for such cargo.

The Surveyor should check the figures given for the cooling test & state what temperatures were actually attained.
