A Special Survey No.3 (after an early No.3 in December 1919) became due on this vessel in December 1931, and no part of this survey was held. The vessel was laid up under the undertaking, and in February last she was generally examined and reported to be in satisfactory condition. In July last she was acquired by Mr. Achille Lauro, of Naples, who stated he did not require any survey by this Society. The case received the consideration of the Committee on 8th instant when the class was expunged with a Red Line.

The following letter has been received from the Owner :-

"We have to inform you, however, that we certainly object to
"the concluding paragraph of your letter stating that you are
"giving instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from
"the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with
"the Rules, and which is not in accordance with the facts. We
"instructed the agents at Falmouth, Messrs. G.C.Fox & Co. that we
"declined the Lloyd's Register class, and for the steamer to
"proceed under Registro Italiano, in consequence therefore there
"can be no question of non-compliance with the Rules of the
"Lloyd's Register and you can note accordingly".

The case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
