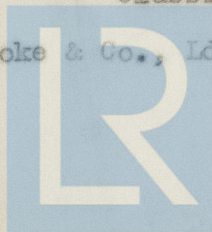
I think it well to enclose for your information a copy of the letter which has been addressed to the Owner conveying this decision.
