A Special Survey No. 3 (after an early No. 3) became due 12.31, and no part of the survey has been held.

The vessel has been laid up and the usual undertaking has been furnished.

In February last (the vessel being more than three years overdue) she was generally examined and reported to be in satisfactory condition.

On the 31st ultimo the Falmouth Surveyors stated that the vessel had been sold to Messrs. Achille Laura, Naples, and that the Owners had approached the Registro Italiano with a view to obtaining a seaworthy certificate to enable the vessel to proceed to Italy, via Rotterdam, with a cargo of coal.

The Falmouth Surveyors were furnished with a copy of the Circular letter recently issued by the Registro Italiano to Italian Shipowners who were contemplating acquiring vessels classed with this Society which were laid up in Ports out of Italy for transference to the Italian Flag, and informed that the necessary survey could be undertaken by the Society's Surveyors.

The Falmouth Surveyors now state that they have interviewed the local Italian Agents and offered their services, but have been informed that the new Owner does not require the services of Lloyd's Register.

The case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
