S.S. "TREGONELL".

This vessel was built at Sunderland in 1918 under the survey of the British Corporation to plans mutually approved by Lloyd's Register and the British Corporation for a "B" type Standard Ship.

The vessel was surveyed by the Society's Surveyors at Newcastle in December, 1919, and on the 13th January, 1920, she was classed by the Committee LOCAL.

The question has now been raised as to when the Special Survey No.1 should be reckoned to become due.

The Newcastle Surveyors have been communicated with, and they state that in their opinion the survey held by them in December, 1919, could be considered as complying with the requirements of the Special Survey No.3.

It is therefore submitted that a notation of S.S. S.Shl. No.3-12,19 should be assigned, the Special Survey No.1 thus becoming due in December 1923.
