This vessel was built by Messrs W. Doxford & Sons at Sunderland 1918, is of the Standard "B" type and classed with the British Corporation.

The Owners have recently taken over the vessel and they desire to have the classification of Lloyd's Register as in common with the rest of their fleet.

The Newcastle Surveyors now report having made a general examination of the vessel afloat and in dry dock, and found her in good condition.

The scantlings have been found in accordance with the plans approved for the Standard "B" type vessel, and the workmanship and materials good.

The Downton Pump has been dispensed with for the present, but it is concluded the Owners are agreeable to fit same when requested.

This vessel appears to have been built in accordance with the plans approved for this type of vessel, and it is submitted might be classed 100 A1. (Steel) as recommended
