In reply to your letter of the 5th instant respecting the steamer "Oregonell" Rwe. Rpt No 72635, I am to advise you that the breadth of the upper deck stringer plate, the thickness of the upper deck plating on the bridge & the thickness of deck plating abreast the hatchways are all as approved for the Standard "B" vessel. The upper deck stringer plate and the deck plating being the same thickness abreast the hatchways amidships viz. 7/16 thick.
