

S.S. "WAR STAG" - STANDARD "A" TYPE.

This vessel was built by Messrs. W. Doxford & Sons at
and in 1918 and is classed with the British Corporation.
A letter has been received from the Hain Steamship Co.,
stating that they are taking over this vessel from the
Company of Shipping and it is desired to have the
classification of Lloyd's Register as is common with the
rest of their fleet.

The vessel is at present discharging in Dunkirk and
will eventually proceed to the Tyne for dry docking and
repairs.

It is submitted the Hain Steamship Co., be informed
that they will be good enough to inform this Office when
the vessel will be in the Tyne for dry docking and also when
the machinery is opened up for examination, the Society's
Surveyors will be instructed to attend.

The Newcastle Surveyors should be advised and requested
to see the matter the necessary when required. The vessel is
a standard ship of the "A" type. The Surveyors should
examine the vessel and her machinery and compare the
drawings and arrangements in the ship with those on the plans
which have been approved by this Society for that Standard type.
Any departures from the approved plans should be reported
to them at once to this Office.

On completion of the survey they should forward their
reports on the First Entry Form, stating also the condition
of the vessel, for the information of the Committee in
concluding with the case.
