Sir,

We beg to state we are informed by the Superintendent Messrs. Lloyd del Pacifico of Savona that this Company has now used the Steamer "WAR COLUMN", No. 33878 in the Supplement to the Register Book and that all Certificates have been received from Messrs. Raeburn & Verel Ltd. with the exception of the Society's Entry Certificates and Freeboard Certificates which it is understood are not in the possession of the late Managers.

As regards the freeboard he has received a provisional certificate issued on official letter paper by the Society's Surveyor Vancouver B.C. on the 3rd July 1919.

The new Owners would be obliged if you would be good enough to state whether the original Classification Certificates were duly issued, and if so to whom, with a view to their being traced as the vessel's name is now being changed to "ATTIVITA", Port of Genoa - Savona. they would be glad if new Freeboard Certificates could be issued accordingly.

We may add that the vessel has been under survey at Genoa Port and the outstanding repairs have received attention.
