There is no survey due on this trawler.

The Society's Surveyor at Boulogne forwards a translation of a letter which he has received from the Owners, dated 15th ultimo, in which they state "In view of future French "Laws which are at present being approved, on the subject of "recommissioning of old vessels, we see ourselves compelled to "discontinue the classification of our trawler "CASTELNAU" with "your Society. We shall, however, always remember our good "relations with your Society. Moreover, we beg to inform you "that in future the trawler "CASTELNAU" will be submitted to the "survey of the Bureau Veritas. We very much regret to have to "take this decision and remain, etc."

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Tuesday, the 4th instant, when they decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, ^{6,35} indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
