
S. I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 17th ultimo from which it is noted that it is not desired to maintain the classification of the steamer "AZANIA" in the Society's Register Book.

The Committee have had the case before them at their meeting today, and I am directed to acquaint you that in view of your intimation instructions have been given for this vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
