

The Special Survey No.1 became due 2,30 and a notice in regard to the same was sent to the Owners on the 11th March, 1930.

No reply being received to this Notice, a letter was addressed to the Owners in December last pointing out that the year of grace will expire at the end of the present month and that it would be necessary for the Special Survey to be carried out before that time in order to maintain the vessel's class.

The Owners now write that as it has been decided not to insure the vessel they no longer find it necessary to maintain her classification. They add that they can find no trace of the receipt of the Notice sent in March last.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Tuesday 24th instant, when they decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
