

S.S. "AZANIA"

The survey of the screwshafts became due at the end of February last.

In reply to an enquiry the Owners (Government of Tanganyika Territory) stated in a letter received on the 27th May last that the vessel had proceeded to Diego Suarez, Madagascar, for dry docking and screwshaft examination.

As the Society has no Surveyor at that port Lloyds Agents were requested on the 3rd June to appoint a Surveyor to carry out the survey.

It now appears that the vessel was dry docked at Diego Suarez on April 16th and the Owners have now forwarded a report from the Acting Chief Engineer from which it appears that the shafts were drawn in and found to be in good condition, and they ask whether that inspection is sufficient for the Society's purposes.

IT IS SUBMITTED that in the circumstances the examination of the shafts made in April last might be accepted in this instance but not recorded in the Register Book.
