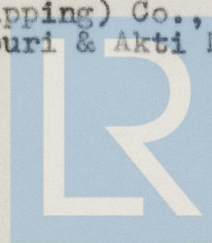
In the circumstances, I shall be glad if you will kindly confirm that this ship has been declared a total loss.
