

and that I am transmitting to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, a report, stating that all repairs recommended by me have been completed to my satisfaction, also that I am recommending that she be continued as now classed without fresh record of survey, subject to the indented stem plating being specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the next drydocking and to all outstanding conditions of class being dealt with as previously recommended.
